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FAKTOR-FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN PERILAKU PERAWAT DALAM PENERAPAN *SURGICAL SAFETY CHECKLIST* DI IBS RSUD Dr. H. ABDUL MOELOEK PROVINSI LAMPUNG TAHUN 2023

ABSTRAK

Penerapan *Surgical Safety Checklist* (SSC) di ruang bedah sering kali menjadi permasalahan bagi tenaga kesehatan khususnya perawat. Dalam peningkatan keselamatan pasien di ruang bedah digunakan formulir *Surgical Safety Checklist* (SSC) sebagai alat komunikasi yang praktis dan sederhana. Berdasarkan WHO angka komplikasi tindakan pembedahan diperkirakan 3-16% dengan kematian 0,4-0,8%. Delapan studi retrospektif tentang kejadian tidak diinginkan (KTD) di rumah sakit, yaitu jumlah insiden terjadi di rumah sakit sebesar 9,2% dan hampir separuhnya dapat dicegah (43,5%). Sebagian besar KTD terjadi saat pasien di rumah sakit (80,8%) dan pada tindakan pembedahan (58,4%). Serta mayoritas (41%) terjadi di kamar bedah. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan perilaku perawat dalam penerapan SSC di IBS RSUD Dr. H. Abdul Moeloek.

Desain penelitian ini adalah *analitik kuantitatif* dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Teknik sampling menggunakan teknik *total sampling*, sampel sebanyak 32 responden, Penelitian dilaksanakan 27 Februari - 17 Maret 2023, dengan uji statistik menggunakan uji *Chi-Square*.

Hasil penelitian didapatkan pada pengetahuan P (0,003), pendidikan P (0,002), sikap P (0,001), motivasi P (0,025), dan masa kerja P (0,003). Hal ini dapat disimpulkan ada hubungan antara pengetahuan, pendidikan, sikap, motivasi, dan masa kerja dengan perilaku perawat dalam penerapan *Surgical Safety Checklist* (SSC). Peneliti menyarankan kepada pihak rumah sakit untuk mendukung penerapan *Surgical Safety Checklist* (SSC). Selain itu juga diperlukan strategi program dalam upaya meningkatkan perilaku perawat dalam penerapan SSC seperti melakukan supervisi, pendampingan dan *in house training* secara berkala guna meningkatkan pengetahuan, sikap dan motivasi.

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**FACTORS RELATED TO NURSE BEHAVIOR IN THE APPLICATION OF
SURGICAL SAFETY CHECKLIST AT IBS OF RSUD Dr. H. ABDUL
MOELOEK LAMPUNG PROVINCE 2023**

ABSTRACT

The application of the Surgical Safety Checklist (SSC) in the operating room is often a problem for health workers, especially nurses. In improving patient safety in the operating room, the Surgical Safety Checklist (SSC) form is used as a practical and simple communication tool. Based on WHO, the complication rate for surgery is estimated at 3-16% with a mortality of 0.4-0.8%. Eight retrospective studies of adverse events in hospitals, namely the number of incidents that occurred in the hospital was 9.2% and almost half were preventable (43.5%). Most of the adverse events occurred while the patient was in the hospital (80.8%) and during surgery (58.4%). And the majority (41%) occurred in the operating room. The purpose of this study was to determine the factors associated with the behavior of nurses in the implementation of SSC in IBS RSUD Dr. H. Abdul Moeloek.

Design of this research is quantitative analytic with cross-sectional coach. The sampling technique uses a total sampling technique, a sample of 32 respondents. The research was conducted February 27 - March 17, 2023, with statistical tests using the Chi-Square test.

The results of the study were obtained on knowledge P (0.003), education P (0.002), attitude P (0.001), motivation P (0.025), and years of service P (0.003). It can be concluded that there is a relationship between knowledge, education, attitudes, motivation, and years of service with the behavior of nurses in applying the Surgical Safety Checklist (SSC). Researchers suggest to the hospital support the implementation of the Surgical Safety Checklist (SSC). In addition, program strategies are also needed in an effort to improve nurse behavior in implementing SSC, such as conducting regular supervision, mentoring, and in-house training to increase knowledge, attitude, and motivation.
