ABSTRAK

Informed Consent adalah suatu bentuk kesepakatan atau persetujuan pasien terhadap upaya medis yang akan dilakukan. Seringkali *informed consent* medis diberikan oleh perawat, tetapi tidak menjelaskan *informed consent* lisan karena biasanya perawat langsung melakukan tindakan tanpa melewati tahap-tahap *informed consent*. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk melihat hubungan kemampuan otonomi pasien dengan metode pemberian *informed consent* pada pasien operasi elektif di ruang rawat inap bedah RSUD Dr. H. Abdul Moeloek Provinsi Lampung. Jenis penelitian ini kuantitatif, desain analitik dengan *cross sectional*, dilaksanakan pada tanggal 06 Maret-06 April 2023, populasi adalah pasien operasi elektif, dengan besar sampel 104 responden, analisis menggunakan uji *chi square*. Hasil penelitian ini menyatakan metode pemberian *informed consent* kurang baik sebanyak 46 responden (44,2%) dan metode baik sebanyak 58 responden (55,8%), kemampuan otonomi tidak mampu sebanyak 37 responden (35,6%) dan mampu sebanyak 67 responden (64,4%). Analisis uji *chi square* menyatakan 55,8% metode pemberiaan *informed consent* baik, dan 64,4% responden menyatakan mampu melakukan kemampuan otonomi, dimana *p-value* 0,00 (<0,05), artinya H_0 ditolak atau ada hubungan antara kemampuan otonomi pasien dengan metode pemberian *informed consent*. Saran untuk peneliti selanjutnya, diharapkan hasil penelitian ini menjadi dasar penelitian selanjutnya yang menitik beratkan varian metode-metode yang paling baik untuk memberikan *informed consent*.

ABSTRACT

Informed Consent is a form of patient agreement or approval of medical efforts to be carried out. Often informed consent medical is given by nurses, but does not explain informed consent verbal because usually nurses immediately take action without going through the stages of informed consent. The purpose of this study was to see the relationship ability patient autonomy and the method of giving informed consent to elective surgery patients in the surgical inpatient room of RSUD Dr. H. Abdul Moeloek Lampung Province. This type of research is quantitative, analytic design with cross sectional, conducted on March 6-April 6 2023, the population is elective surgery patients, with a large sample of 104 respondents, the analysis uses the chi square test. The results of this study stated that the method of giving informed consent was not good enough for 46 respondents (44.2%) and the method was good for 58 respondents (55.8%), the ability of autonomy not capable of as many as 37 respondents (35.6%) and capable of as many as 67 respondents (64.4%). Chi square test analysis stated that 55.8% of the method of giving informed consent was good, and 64.4% of respondents said they were able to practice autonomy abilities, where the p-value was 0.00 (<0.05), meaning that H_0 was rejected or there was a relationship between ability patient autonomy with the method of giving informed consent. Suggestions for future researchers, it is hoped that the results of this study will become the basis for further research that focuses on the best variant of methods for giving informed consent.
