ABSTRAK

Afasia Wernicke didefinisikan sebagai penyakit gangguan bahasa yang terjadi akibat kerusakan pada area otak yang mengontrol pemahaman bahasa, khususnya di area *wernicke* di korteks temporalis. Data RS Mardi Waluyo Kota Metro mencatat 1 kasus *afasia wernicke* selama Januari 2024 hingga Januari 2025. *Afasia* ini menyebabkan penderita kesulitan dalam memahami bahasa dan berbicara, meskipun kemampuan motorik dan kecerdasan umumnya tidak terganggu. Berdasarkan data di Ruang Flamboyan RS Mardi Waluyo Metro tahun 2025 bulan Januari, diperoleh data penyakit *afasia wernicke* sebanyak 1 kasus dari 30 pasien yang sedang dirawat di Ruang Flamboyan RS Mardi Waluyo Metro tahun 2025. Tujuan asuhan keperawatan ini adalah memberikan gambaran pelaksanaan asuhan keperawatan gangguan pemenuhan interaksi sosial pada pasien *afasia wernicke*. Metode penulisan menggunakan pendekatan asuhan keperawatan berfokus pada 1 (satu) subjek asuhan yang mengalami gangguan komunikasi verbal dengan menggunakan format asuhan keperawatan medikal bedah, asuhan keperawatan dilakukan selama tiga hari dari tanggal 7 sampai 9 Januari 2025. Hasil dari asuhan keperawatan pada pasien *afasia wernicke* gangguan kebutuhan interaksi sosial selama 3 hari didapatkan data pasien masih mengatakan kalimat terbata-bata, mendengar dengan jelas sedikit membaik, menunjukan respon sesuai sedikit membaik, pelo menurun. Hasil asuhan ini diharapkan dapat mengembangkan program edukasi bagi pasien dan keluarga mengenai pencegahan dan penatalaksanaan *afasia wernicke*, termasuk pengelolaan faktor risiko seperti, hipertensi, stroke non hemoragik, cedera otak, demensia dan gaya hidup tidak sehat.

ABSTRACT

Wernicke's Aphasia is defined as a language disorder resulting from damage to the area of the brain that controls language comprehension, specifically in Wernicke's area in the temporal cortex. RS Mardi Waluyo Metro city data recorded 1 case of wernicke aphasia during January 2024 to January 2025. This aphasia causes sufferers to have difficulty understanding language and speaking, although motor skills and intelligence are generally not impaired. Based on data from the Flamboyant Ward of Mardi Waluyo Metro Hospital in January 2025, it was found that there was 1 case of Wernicke's aphasia out of 30 patients being treated in the Flamboyant Ward of Mardi Waluyo Metro Hospital in 2025. The aim of this nursing care is to provide an overview of the implementation of nursing care for impaired social interaction needs in patients with Wernicke's aphasia. The writing method uses a nursing care approach focused on 1 (one) care subject experiencing verbal communication impairment using a medical-surgical nursing care format, with nursing care provided over three days from January 7th to 9th, 2025. The results of the nursing care for a patient with Wernicke's aphasia experiencing impaired social interaction needs over 3 days showed that the patient still spoke hesitant sentences, had slightly improved clear hearing, showed slightly improved appropriate responses, and decreased dysarthria. The results of this care are expected to support the development of an educational program for patients and their families regarding the prevention and management of Wernicke's aphasia, including the management of risk factors such as hypertension, non-hemorrhagic stroke, brain injury, dementia, and unhealthy lifestyles.
