ABSTRAK

Indonesia memiliki kekayaan alam dan budaya yang mendukung pemanfaatan obat tradisional, namun masih ditemukan obat tradisional yang tidak memenuhi standar keamanan dan mutu. Pengetahuan mahasiswa kesehatan tentang obat tradisional berlogo dinilai penting agar mereka dapat menjadi agen edukasi di masyarakat. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menggambarkan tingkat pengetahuan mahasiswa Politeknik Kesehatan Tanjungpurang mengenai obat tradisional berlogo.

Penelitian menggunakan metode deskriptif kuantitatif dengan teknik accidental sampling pada 100 mahasiswa dari 15 program studi. Data dikumpulkan melalui kuesioner dan dianalisis secara univariat. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan sebagian besar responden adalah perempuan (92%) dan berusia dewasa (>19 tahun, 80%). Tingkat pengetahuan responden mayoritas baik (89%), cukup (10%), dan kurang (1%). Program studi dengan pengetahuan kategori baik 100% antara lain D3 Farmasi, D3 Kesehatan Gigi, D3 Teknologi Laboratorium Medis, D3 Teknik Gigi, D3 Kebidanan Tanjungpurang, D4 Kebidanan Tanjungpurang, D4 Kebidanan Metro, D3 Keperawatan Tanjungpurang, dan D3 Sanitasi Lingkungan. Pengetahuan tertinggi ada pada aspek klasifikasi obat tradisional, identifikasi logo, serta jenis dan bentuk sediaan, sedangkan aspek dosis, efek samping, dan kontraindikasi masih kurang. Edukasi lebih lanjut dibutuhkan untuk meningkatkan pengetahuan terkait keamanan penggunaan obat tradisional.

**OVERVIEW OF THE LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE OF TRADITIONAL MEDICINE
WITH LOGOS AMONG STUDENTS AT THE TANJUNGKARANG HEALTH
POLYTECHNIC**

ABSTRACT

Indonesia has natural and cultural resources that support the use of traditional medicine, but there are still traditional medicines that do not meet safety and quality standards. Students' knowledge of traditional medicines with logos is considered important so that they can become agents of education in the community. This study aims to describe the level of knowledge of Tanjungkarang Health Polytechnic students regarding traditional medicines with logos.

The study employed a quantitative descriptive method with accidental sampling on 100 students from 15 programs. Data were collected through questionnaires and analyzed using univariate analysis. The results showed that the majority of respondents were female (92%) and adults (>19 years old, 80%). The level of knowledge among respondents was mostly good (89%), adequate (10%), and poor (1%). Programs with 100% good knowledge included D3 Pharmacy, D3 Dental Health, D3 Medical Laboratory Technology, D3 Dental Technology, D3 Midwifery Tanjungkarang, D4 Midwifery Tanjungkarang, D4 Midwifery Metro, D3 Nursing Tanjungkarang, and D3 Environmental Sanitation. The highest level of knowledge was in the aspects of traditional medicine classification, logo identification, and types and forms of preparations, while aspects of dosage, side effects, and contraindications were still lacking. Further education is needed to improve knowledge related to the safe use of traditional medicines.
